

Our Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths days this week - The whole school has had an exciting problem to solve since coming back from the Christmas holidays - building a mode of transport for a minion! We

set the children the problem of helping minions get from their land to Fair Furlong Primary School. Phase I were given the task of making a mode of transport that carried the minions over water; phase 2 had to navigate over land and phase 3 designed an air craft.

First the children were given their brief then set to work researching existing modes of transports. Once this information was gathered they began to test which materials would be best suited for their model.







Then children began to use their knowledge of products and testing to design their own mode of transport. After the design process was

finished they built their model. Here are some examples!

Finally, on Friday their vehicles were put to

the test. Phase I tested their models on water, phase 2 on


different surfaces and phase 3 sent

parachutes, rockets and planes through the air.

Over these three exciting days the children explored and applied their learning in maths and computing. The children were able to challenge their mathematical thinking when measuring how far their vehicle

travelled and applying this to problem solving. An important part of the engineering process is computing so we exposed the children to the exiting world of coding. Children used beebots to navigate their way from minion land to our school or planned their route on a map using a detailed algorithm.

The three days allowed children to become creative, innovative engineers and they got thoroughly immersed in the design process. What an exciting start to term 3!


























Year 2/3 Performance next term is 'Tattybogle'
