<u>Sweetcorn Fritters</u>

150g plain flour

14 tsp baking powder

1/2 tsp sea salt

I tsp ground coriander

1/2 tsp ground cumin

I tsp sweet paprika

I egg, lightly beaten

I tsp lemon juice

350g corn kernels, cut from 3 large corn cobs

4 spring onions, thinly sliced

3 tbsp chopped coriander

2 thsp olive oil

To prepare the fritters, place the flour, baking powder, salt, coriander, cumin and paprika in a bowl. Add the egg, lemon juice and 125ml of water and beat to a smooth batter. Add the corn, spring onion and chopped coriander and stir to combine. Heat a frying pan on a medium heat and put in a good drizzle of oil. Fry off the fritters in batches dolloping a good spoonful of mixture in the hot pan. When golden brown on both sides serve immediately with a wedge of lime and some yogurt.
