## Queen Elizabeth II


We were all saddened to hear the news yesterday that Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II had passed away at Balmoral.

## What's Been Happening this Week?















DATA PROTECTION REGULATION – You may not be aware but the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force in May 2018. We are required to conduct due diligence for all parents to be aware of the regulation and how it affects their child and the way the school deals with their personal data.
