On a Friday afternoon 3 names are pulled out from each year group (Y1-Y6) and then on a Monday

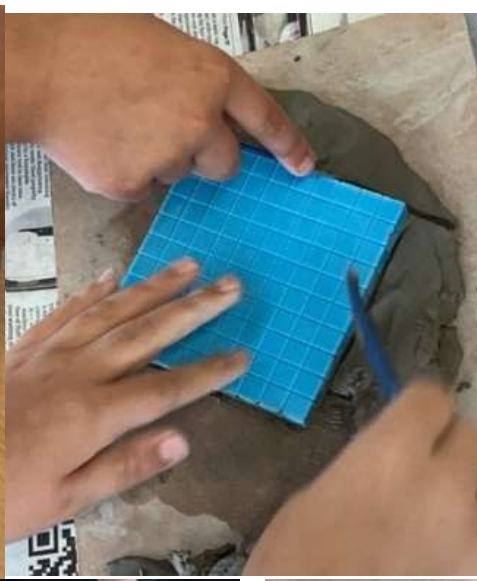
these children get the chance to have their dinner early, sit at the Golden Table using golden

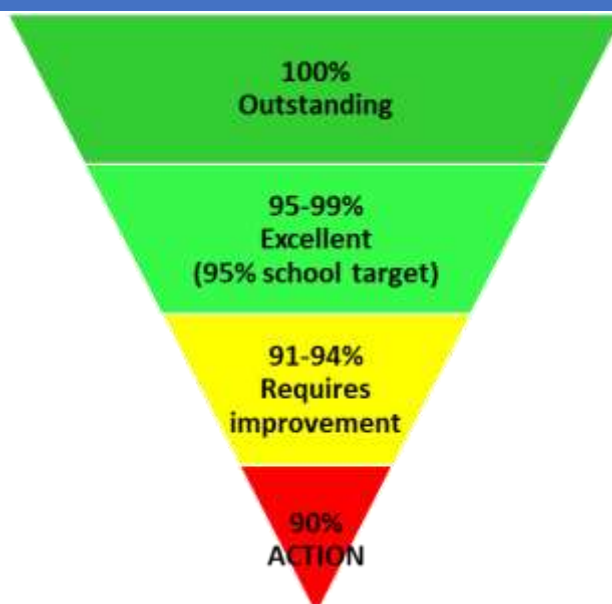

DATA PROTECTION REGULATION - You may not be aware but the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force in May 2018.
