#### **Industrial Action**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Members of the National Education Union in England have voted in favour of strike action, and have called for 4 days of strikes, the first of which will be on Wednesday 1st February 2023.

After careful consideration and consultation with the governors, of the information we have available to us, we have made the decision that the school will be closed on Wednesday 1st February to all children except to children with Education Health Care Plans and those defined as vulnerable by the DfE and/or identified by our school risk assessment. These families will be contacted by the school to confirm their child/ren's place in school. Please do not plan to send your children to school until you have received confirmation from us that your child/ren has a place in the emergency provision.

The decision to close the school has not been taken lightly and the decision of individual members of staff to take strike action will not have been easy. The aim of the strike is to try and secure fully funded pay increases for teachers. This is a response, not only to the cost of living crisis, but also to the increasing pressures on school budgets and the recruitment and retention crisis in education.

For now, we ask you to make arrangements for your children not to attend school on 1st February. We will inform you in due course of arrangements for further strike dates if the action continues.






Noah B has also been showing us his amazing football trophies – such a wonderful collection. Congratulations on such a fab trophy haul Noah!
