School was a sea of red today for Red Nose Day. Mr Thomas set us off on our Marvellous Maths Day during assembly and activities have taken place in classes throughout the day.

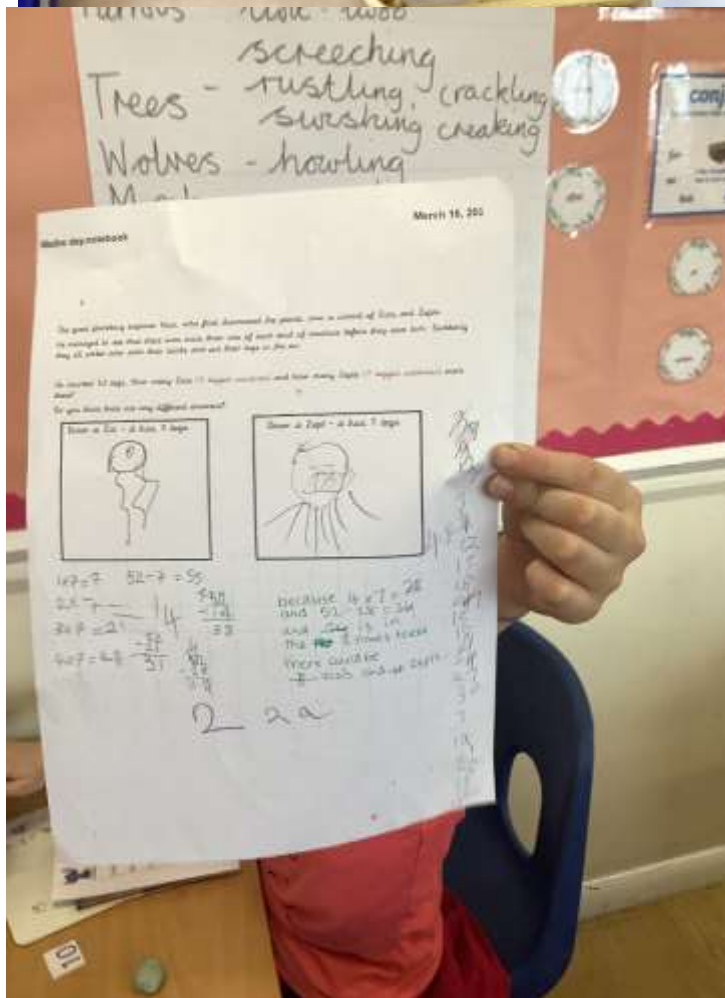


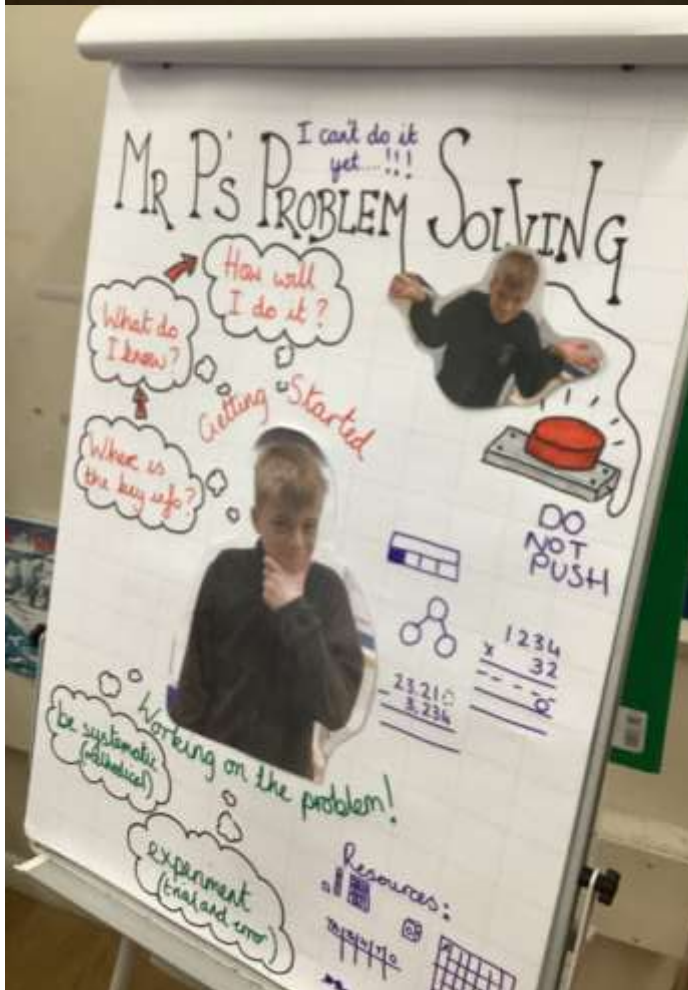
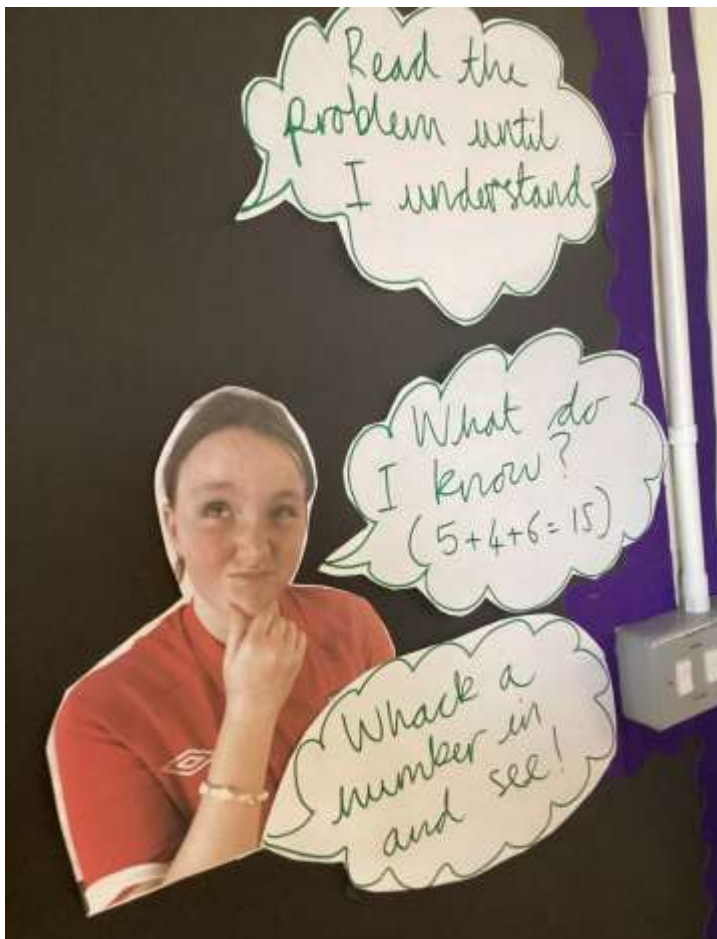
